Greetings from Ukraine and welcome to the circle of Friends of Dzherelo! We were informed that on your initiative we received wheelchairs for the disabled, we would like to express our heartfelt gratitude. Our Centre has 28 years of experience in supporting the impaired children and youth with disabilities, we have a workshop of rehabilitation equipment, the wheelchairs you have sent us will be configured by our qualified specialists, and then distributed to the refugee families who have found a place of temporary residence in our Centre.

We are sad that the reason for our acquaintance is so tragic, but we are still glad that we have the honor of receiving such support and making new friends. For your support of Ukraine, please accept our sincere gratitude from the whole Lviv community. Lately there have been more and more such manifestations of help, which proves once again: the whole world is with Ukraine and it will not leave us in a difficult moment.

Before the war broke out, our Centre provided day care services for children and youth with disabilities. For 28 years of our operation, 7500 families received professional support, with circa 400 children visiting us daily. Since the start of Russia's invasion we provide temporary residence for refugee families, who have children with disabilities. We have around 100 places in our Centre, we provide food, water, clothing, hot meals, medicines, wheelchairs for these people. Also, we have a Refugee Assistant Post operating of the railway station, our volunteers meet people from trains, help them with their settlement in the city. Lviv serves as a transit point – most of these families end their journey abroad.

The wheelchairs you have provided us with are extremely important for the refugee families, who live in Dzherelo at the moment: a lot of these people did not have an opportunity to bring supporting equipment for their children, but mobility for the impaired is highly valued, it empowers them, gives them a sense of independence they desperately require. Thank you! Together to victory!

We, Ukrainians, feel more than ever the encouragement that public support gives us. With such friends, Ukraine will never disappear from the map of the world, but will prosper, in harmony with itself. We express our deep gratitude for the humanitarian aid to Ukraine and to people with disabilities during the war.
